What concepts do you hope will be included in UUCR's new mission statement as a way to move the congregation forward in the next five to ten years?

Goals for Mission / Purpose Work

- Create a new mission statement, to include in ministerial search materials
- Live into the mindset of what it means to be a mission-based congregation.

- Each participant should feel free to speak openly and express opinions which are in keeping with the values of UUCR, without fear of critique from others in the conversation
- Each participant shall have enough time to express her or his view and opinion.
- Each participant should remain aware that this is a group conversation and do what she or he can to provide time for everyone who wishes to speak
- Each person will be encouraged to discern how she or he can contribute to the on-going work of discerning Mission and Purpose for UUCR and helping UUCR live as a mission-based community after these Cottage / Library meeting are concluded.
